### **Intercultural Experience:**

**3-15 credits**

Students have to complete an intercultural experience. This requirement is fulfilled through a semester-long study abroad experience, a faculty-led travel course, or an internship with a central intercultural component. The Intercultural experience must be approved by the Coordinator for International Studies.

### **Electives:**

**13-15 credits**

Students must complete 5 electives from the International Studies course offerings of the Anthropology, Economics, History, and Political Science disciplines. To receive the History & Culture concentration students must take 4 of the following as their electives. The remaining elective can be chosen freely from any approved International Studies elective. Students cannot take more than 3 courses within one discipline (Anthropology or History). Only 1 course can be a lower-division (100 and 200-level) course. At least 4 must be upper-division (300 and 400-level) courses.
