#### Response Rate

- I really enjoyed this course like all of Professor Popovic courses he helps you learn and do outside research. I was able to broaden my horizon about migration and refugee in a new way.
- There was a lot of content in this course, however it was not overwhelming. But I wish there had been more lectures given by the professor.
- The course was an enjoyable and educational one. Given the political times we are living in, I believe this course was the saving grace on what we need to remember that some of us are fighting. I enjoyed the overall course format. Though I struggle a little with the readings on Persuall, everything else was great content. the discussion boards were a saving grace, so were the various methods of receiving information such as videos and text combo, it allowed me personally to learn at my own pace. I am actually living this class capable of remembering information, which I cannot unfortunately says for many of my classes, it is quite a big deal.
- The course being synchronous and online course created certain challenges, however, the course content was shaped sufficiently to overcome these issues. Using Persuall and Moodle forums we were able to participate with other students on sometimes hard to grasp peer-reviewed papers, all the while doing unique exercises like interviews, which allowed for the implementation of information into real-life skills. This course, although plagued by the drawbacks of virtual learning, the shape and plan of the course was set up thoughtfully and allowed for many students to succeed sometimes rare in other virtual classrooms.
- The course is definitely something that is out of my element which was originally nerve-wracking but ultimately extremely interesting and applicable to many of the things I had learned as a sociology major. It was nice realizing that I'm not as much of a fish out of water as I had thought. Keeping in mind, this is my final semester at SUNY Potsdam and the third (technically second and a half since it started at the halfway point of spring 2020) semester spent online so I am extremely burnt out. The course material seemed to be extremely heavy, however, fitting of an upper-division course. Students must be willing to make a genuine time commitment to the course in order to be successful but it is so jam-packed with valuable information that you could easily learn massive amount of content without truly applying yourself.

After taking Professor Popovic again, his biggest strength is being tough on grading and pushing students to do their best work, at the same time, he is available for every student to work through an issue that is halting their successes in the course.
- I am so grateful to have had the opportunity to take a course with Professor Popovic before graduating SUNY Potsdam. He is wholeheartedly one of the fairest and caring professors SUNY Potsdam has to offer.
